Notice of Race

The Organizing Authority is Helsingfors Segelsällskap Classic Yacht Committee – HSS CYC in co-operation with Scandinavian Classic Yacht Trust – SCYT.

- 1 Date**
The regatta will be held at August 6-7th 2011.
- 2 Rules**
The racing will be covered as designated in the Racing Rules of Sailing ISAF RRS 2009-2012. On individual racing classes class rules will be applied.
- 3 Insurances**
Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 250.000 for material damages and EUR 500.000 for personal injuries.
- 4 Advertising**
Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 5 Eligibility and Entry**
 - 5.1 The regatta is open for all owners of Star Class Yachts, Dragon Class Yachts, Haj Class Yachts, Skerry Cruiser Yachts (SK 15, SK 22, SK 30, SK 40, SK 55, SK 75, SK 95, SK 120, SK 150), A-Båt Yachts, diverse Kryssare Yachts and Metre Class Yachts (5m, 5.5m, 6mR, 8mR, 10mR).
 - 5.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form by July 23rd 2011, 12.00 hours.
 - 5.2.1 The absolutely latest entry time is August 5th 2011, 18.00 hours. A post entry fee of EUR 30 is required to be paid on top of the entry fee on the entries delivered after the official latest entry time July 23rd 2011, 12.00 hours.
 - 5.3 Entry form, see www.hss-cyc.com.
 - 5.4 The regatta is a part of the Baltic Classic Circuit series. Yacht owners who want to compete in the Baltic Classic Circuit series are required to register with the SCYT. Registration to ahoy@sailtrust.org.
- 6 Fees**
Entry fees:
EUR 80: Star, Dragon, Haj, SK 15, SK 22, SK 30, SK 40, A-Båt, 5m, 5.5m.
EUR 100: SK 55, SK 75, diverse Kryssare, 6mR.
EUR 120: SK 95, SK 120, SK 150, 8mR, 10mR.
- 7 Entry fee payment**
 - 7.1 Entry fee is required to be paid immediately after completing and sending the entry form.

 - 7.3 Please make sure to mention also in the payment the regatta name CNF BCMC HELSINKI 2011, your Yacht name, class and sail number.
 - 7.4 A copy of the receipt or an account statement is required to be presented prior to receiving the regatta flag.

8 Schedule of Races

- 8.1 The detailed schedule will be available on Friday August 5th 2011, 09.00 hours, from the www.hss-cyc.com website and the regatta office at the HSS premises.
- 8.2 The number of races planned: 3 races on each day. Warning Signal for the 1st race: 10.55.
- 8.3 After finishing a race a new race will be started soonest possible.

9 Measurements

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
Organizers reserve the right to check the measurement certificate.
Organizers reserve the right to conduct measurement checks before, during or after any race.

10 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be latest available on Friday August 5th 2011, 09.00 hours, from the www.hss-cyc.com website and the regatta office at the HSS premises.

11 Venues

The regatta harbor will be HSS harbor at Skifferholmen - island Helsinki Finland 60°09.077' 24°56.873'.

12 Mooring and haul out restrictions

All yachts must be moored at the designated berths at the HSS harbor. Free mooring is available from August 5th to August 12th.

13 The Courses

The courses for the races will classical upper – lower mark courses. The courses will be sailed on the waters south of Helsinki.

14 Scoring

- 14.1 Low point scoring system shall be employed. When four of more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst race. Individual classes will race as class yachts in their respective classes. If the amount of yachts in a class is under three the yachts on this respective class will race by the FinLYS in the diverse Kryssare class.
- 14.2 The boats competing for the Baltic Classic Master Cup will be scoring by the FinLYS. More details of the scoring on the Baltic Classic Circuit is available on SCYT web-site www.sailtrust.org.
- 14.3 2010-2011 The Baltic Classic Circuit Baltic Rule will be run parallel to the FinLYS to test the 2010 established rule. As the organizers look to run the Baltic Rule a proper test the competing classic yachts and those wishing to compete in the Baltic Classic Circuit are asked to fill out a VDC book available on the SCYT web-site online. For more information on the VDC book and the Baltic Rule see SCYT web-site www.sailtrust.org.

15 Radio communication

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

16 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded by class. The winner of each class will be awarded. Prize giving will take place on August 7th 2011 soonest possible after racing. The Official Prize Giving Ceremony will be held in front of the eastern sails dryind shed under the 8 metre main sail. See also the Notice of Party at www.hss-cyc.com.
