The Baltic Classic Master Cup Helsinki second edition is launched now, entry open on www.hss-cyc.com!

A new classic regatta – **The Champagne Nicolas Feuillatte Baltic Classic Master Cup** - is organized in Helsinki on August 6th and 7th 2011 by HSS Classic Yacht Committee. The regatta is a part of the **Baltic Classic Circuit**. HSS - CYC promoted the series right from the very beginning of the Circuit by launching the new regatta in August 2010 for the first time.

The regatta is organized in co-operation with the **Scandinavian Classic Yacht Trust - SCYT**. The mission of the Trust is to make sure classic yachts are sailed and seen. We, the CYC and the SCYT, believe this is the best way to make the yachts desired and preserved as part of our cultural heritage.

The Baltic Classic Circuit was announced earlier at 2010 for the Northern Baltic region. The series is based on the new tailor made handicap rule, the **Baltic Rule**, for classic yachts.

Date:

The regatta will take place on August 6th and 7th, and compared to the prototype year 2010 it is extended to last a full weekend from Saturday morning to Sunday evening.

Racing:

The racing will consist of three race starts on each day. The classic triangular Olympic courses are arranged to waters south of Helsinki. The regatta will be a national challenge competition for the international 5m and 8mR yacht classes in Finland (Finland has the largest fleets of both the previous classes in the world). This means that compared to year 2010 even more classic yachting women and men will be celebrating at the 2011 event.

The international character of the event is also further emphasized as the role of the international yachts and yachts women and men is further emphasized. At the 2011 event 70 classic yachts are expected to participate in the race. 350 yachts women and men are expected to visit the HSS Skifferholmen island on each day of the regatta.

Celebrations:

The 2011 event at the HSS yacht club island will be hosted with two different restaurants. At the HSS yacht club building is the Palace Kämp -group HSS Boathouse restaurant. New for 2011 is a high quality pop-up restaurant at the eastern boathouse on the island. The restaurant concept "CD on island" is built by the Helsinki based world class restaurant Chez Dominique.

Classic regatta dinners on Saturday evening and celebrational late lunches on Sunday will be available for the participants of the event at the location.
